PLAY WITH US!

CRAZY COLOURS (aka—Toddler Twister)

You'll need: Pieces of coloured paper, or white paper and crayons

Find pieces of paper in each colour of the rainbow. (If you're using white paper, use the crayons to colour one piece of paper in each colour.) Place the pieces of paper randomly on the floor. Call out a colour and a body part — "Put your feet on the yellow paper!". Let your child find the coloured paper, and follow your instructions, then move on to a new colour and body parts.

Variations: Choose a movement to accompany each colour transition— "Hop like a rabbit to the red paper". For more of a challenge, place the papers in a grid, and play like traditional Twister, where you keep one body part on a paper even while you move to the next one -"Place your left foot on the green paper. Place your right hand on the yellow paper."

If you see the colour (red) point it out!


Repeat for all colours

RAINBOW CLOUD WEAVING

You'll need: Scissors, a large piece of white paper, & large pieces of coloured paper (rainbow or your choice)

Draw a large cloud that covers the entire white paper and cut it out. Fold the cloud in half vertically, and cut 5 or 6 horizontal lines across the centre of the fold, leaving about 1" uncut at the edges (don't cut all the way through!). Next, cut long strips of your coloured paper in any width you'd like. Weave a coloured strip of paper through the cloud, and repeat until your cloud is filled with a rainbow!
