Children's Ministry - Our in-person programming for children is as follows: The Nursery (Room 119) is open but unsupervised for children aged 0-2. Preschool-Aged Children (2-5 years) are invited to head to Room 109 where a new area is set-up for them. Gradeschool Children taking part in Sunday School will start in the sanctuary for a couple of songs before being invited to their class (Grade 1-4, Fellowship Hall & Grade 5-6, Youth Room). Please accompany them to meet their leaders if it is their first time. Gradeschool Children will be escorted back to the Sanctuary to join their parents/guardians near the end of the service. During Advent, all children will be joining their families/caregivers in the Sanctuary for these family-friendly services.
